Overview

To provide an interim solution until the EMD (Electronic Miscellaneous Document) is implemented, Travelport released an enhancement on December 9, 2008 to transmit an automated SSR MCOA message to applicable carriers to identify system generated MCO numbers when an automated MCO is issued.

The SSR MCOA message applies only to 'paperless' automated MCOs issued in BSP (Bank Settlement Plan) markets.

The SSR MCOA message does not apply to 'Service Fee' MCOs.

As a follow-up to the December 9, 2008 release (described above), Document History is being enhanced to store and display that an SSR MCOA item has been created and sent to a carrier.

Customer Benefit

- Confirm system generated SSR notification to the airline upon MCO issuance.
- Industry standard to avoid confusion and promote consistency.

Detail and Customer Examples

- 1. Document History
 - 1.1. A new element for the automated SSR MCOA message will display in the Document History. The new element identifier is TMN (Transmit MCO Number) and will display as part of the MCO 'grouping' elements in the Document History.
 - 1.2. The new element identifier of TMN (Transmit MCO Number) will be added to the Document History when an automated SSR MCOA message is transmitted.

The following is an example of the document history (partial display) to show the new TMN element identifier and data (shown in bold for illustration only) in the document history display.
