Overview

Allow new and updated mandate changes to the SSR and TTY products. Current processing will not be changed but required amendments will be made to allow modification to existing functionality.

- There will be two new meal codes added; additionally some codes will be deleted. There are also some changes to the descriptions of some existing meal codes.
- The SSR DOCO field for the VISA number will have a maximum length of 15 alpha-numeric characters.
- One SSR DOCA will be allowed when a family or party is traveling together and they all reside at the same address and /or are staying at the same address.
- An optional 180 characters of free text will be allowed to the existing SSR BIKE.

These changes will be allowed via Droptthrough and for United Airlines and Reservation Sales Solution (RSS) users.

Customer Benefit

- This effort will allow our customers to use the new enhancements including the industry mandated changes to SSR meals.

Detail and Customer Examples – SSR Meal Codes

Two new meal codes will be added all three cores, Galileo, Worldspan and Apollo:

- VJML – Vegetarian Jain Meal
- VOML – Vegetarian Oriental Meal

These meals codes will be applicable for flights leaving June 1st 2009 or later. If entered for a flight leaving prior to that date the system will accept it and send the message to the airline however the airline will reject it.



1. The following meal code [descriptions will change](#) for all flights departing after 31st May 2009:

It is particularly important to take note of the name changes as these may affect passengers with allergies to certain food types.

For example, SSR GFML used to mean GLUTEN FREE MEAL. After 1st June it will mean GLUTEN INTOLERANT MEAL. This is not the same thing. The airline will not be able to guarantee that the food is 100% free of gluten – traces may still exist and this could be important for your passenger if they are expecting a wholly gluten free meal.

- The following SSRs will be **removed and not offered** on flights departing 1st June 2009 and later. If entered before the load date for a flight leaving after 1st June the system will accept it and send the message to the airline however the airline will reject it:

HFML – HIGH FIBRE MEAL LPML – LOW PROTEIN MEAL ORML – ORIENTAL MEAL PRML – LOW PURIN MEAL

If there are any ClientFiles, PRO-Files or Worldfiles with these codes in, it would be prudent to remove these codes from the customer's profiles and notify them accordingly that across the airline industry these meals are no longer available.

Effective May 31st, 2009 the meals codes above will be removed from the system. If entered after that time an error response will be received as follows:

One SSR DOCA will be allowed when a family or party is traveling together and they all reside at the same address and /or staying at the same address.

Teletype messages will still go out for each person per segment.
