High Level Description	ATPCO Category 31 carrier filings that require the refunding of a residual amount and an additional collection of a penalty amount in a single reissue transaction will now be processed.

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OVERVIEW

Once Rapid Reprice processing has determined applicable change fee(s) the result is then used in connection with the lowest re-pricing solution to determine the additional collection/refund. When a residual amount exists (previous fare is greater than the new fare), the Residual/Penalty field specifies how to resolve the residual amount for the fare and the change fee.

Rapid Reprice currently processes values in the Residual/Penalty field that either

- 1) ignores the residual amount and collects the penalty fee

OR

- 2) applies the residual amount towards the penalty

With this implementation Rapid Reprice will begin processing a value that refunds the residual amount to script and add collect the penalty.

When byte 84 is R and byte 85 is S (script), M (MCO), or V (voucher), the fare difference and the penalty will display on the FINAL RESULTS screen as it does today, but the additional collection will be the penalty amount only.

The EXCHANGE ELEMENT screen will be populated with the residual fare amount and write protected to force the refund of residual value to an MCO.

CUSTOMER BENEFIT

By processing the new value, 1P agency subscribers will now be able to handle reissues that require both a refund and the collection of penalty amounts in a single transaction.

DETAIL AND CUSTOMER EXAMPLES

The following example of a Rapid Reprice FINAL RESULT screen in Worldspan, illustrates a negative fare difference (new fare is lower than the original fare) and a total additional collection of the change fee only. The two amounts are not netted.

When the Final Result Screen is confirmed the EXCHANGE ELEMENT Screen is displayed with the RESIDUAL VALUE MCO field as Y and write protected. The agent cannot modify the field.

Previous Fare = 328.50

New Fare = 254.50

Penalty = 150.00

Processing will collect the penalty amount (150.00) and refund the residual amount (74.00) to script (MCO).

For agencies hosted in Worldspan (1P), Rapid Reprice processing will create a DI line that reflects the exchanged (old) document and penalty amounts and issue an automated MCO for the residual value:

Note – the penalty amount - /AP is not deducted from the residual value amount
