

Galileo ARO Script Installation Guide

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1 Introduction

1.1 Purpose of the Document

This document is the solution proposal for the ARO Release. It describes in detail the steps involved to Install the ARO Release.

1.2 Scope

The scope for this document is limited to the ARO Scripts only.



2 Installation Steps

The Install Shield Developer 8 creates a setup file of ARO script. Click on this executable file of ARO script.

2.1 Pre-requisites

The following software should be installed on the computer before installing this setup.

- Galileo Desktop Version 2.x
- Windows® 2000 SP3, Windows® NT Service Pack 6a, Windows® Me and Windows® XP or Higher.
- Microsoft® Internet Explorer 6.0 or Higher

2.3 Checking of Galileo Desktop

As the user clicks on next button, there are some Predefined validations like:

Install Shield first check whether the Galileo Desktop Version 2.x has installed or not. If Galileo Desktop 2.x has not installed on the system then it would prompt a message to the user (Figure 3) and terminate the setup.

2.4 Copying the Files

After validating all the conditions (Checking of Galileo Desktop 2.x) the setup would copy all the files on the specified location. (Figure 5).

As the user install the ARO script a button would be added on the Custom Viewpoint Toolbar of Galileo Desktop. By default the ARO script Installer search the vptoolbar.xml file in <Drive Letter>\fp\swdir folder & subfolders and if this file found then installer do the following steps:



a. If entry with respect to ARO script is not available in VpToolbar.xml file then append a new entry for ARO button and add required Tag to the end of the vptoolbar.xml file.

In case the vptoolbar.xml file is not found, the installer should create the vptoolbar.xml file under <Drive Letter>/FP/SWDIR folder only.
