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1. Introduction

1.1 Purpose of the Document

This document is the solution proposal for the ETI release. It describes in detail the steps involved to install the ETI release.

1.2 Scope

The scope for this document is limited to the ETI application only.

1.3 ETI Functional Items List

Functionality	Description
1) Electronic Ticket Itinerary Mask	This is used to get ticket details of active PNR from the HOST using XML API
2) Settings Mask	This is used to customise settings for Optional Fields in the Ticket Document
3) Template and Image Uploader Mask	Send requests to DPDS to upload default template for the ETI Document
4) Display Mask	Used to display generated ETI Document in the selected formats
5) Help Menu	Contains information about product and release version of ETI.

1.4 Pre-requisites

The following software should be installed on the computer before installing this setup.

- Galileo Desktop 1.x / 2.x
- Windows 2000 SP4 or Higher** (**Windows 7 is not supported)
- Adobe Acrobat 6.0 or higher
- Client ID Configured
- Microsoft Office (2003 or above) or Microsoft Office Viewer

2. Installation Steps

The Install Shield 2008 creates a setup file ETI V 11.0.0111.0.exe.

Click on this executable file of the ETI application.

2.8 Setup Status

After validating all the conditions, the setup would copy all the files on to the specified location. (Figure 14).

After the user installs the ETI application, a button will be added to the Custom Viewpoint Toolbar of Galileo Desktop. By default the ETI application Installer will search the vptoolbar.xml file in <Drive Letter>\fp\swdir folder & subfolders and if this file is found then installer will execute the following steps:

If entry with respect to the ETI application is not available in the VpToolbar.xml file then append a new entry for the ETI button and add required tag to the end of the vptoolbar.xml file.

In the case that the vptoolbar.xml file is not found, the installer will create the vptoolbar.xml file under the <Drive Letter>/FP/SWDIR folder only.
