The scope for this document is limited to the Document Converter 10.1.3.1 only.


## 2. Installation Steps

Before commencing the installation process, please close your Galileo Desktop.

To start the installation process, please double click the DocumentConverter\_10.1.3.1.exe file which you have loaded on your desktop.

### 2.1 Preparing Setup

Document Converter setup is preparing for installation.




Before you can install the software, you have to read the details of License Agreement and accept its terms.




1. If you don't accept the terms of the license agreement, you will receive the following dialog box to reconfirm if you want to cancel the installation.




Click on 'Yes', the installation is terminated and you will find the next screen as follow.



2. If you don't want to terminate the installation at this point, you can click on 'No' now and will go back to the 'License Agreement' page and select 'I accept the terms of the license agreement' to continue the setup.





After this page, the Wizard will search for required components in your computer.



As ItextSharp.dll is one of required software to run the script (please refer to Pre requisite in user guide). While it is not found by the Wizard, you will find the following dialog box and remind you to download a free Itextsharp file version 4.1.2 from a third party's website.


Quoted from the website - iText# (iTextSharp) is a port of the iText open source java library for PDF generation written entirely in C# for the .NET platform.



At this point, you just click on 'OK' and let the Wizard complete the installation process.


### 2.2 Start Copying Files

Document Converter is being installed.



After files are copied, please click on 'Next' Button.

From the mask below, you have to select if you want to install the "Unconverted MIR file mask" functionality on your computer.




If you select **'Enable'** – When a MIR file is unable to be converted by the script, the Unconverted MIR File Preview Window pops up and the document is displayed on the screen (please refer to appendix). Then, it allows you to save, print or send the document via email. Next, the original MIR file will be saved in the following folder. C:\DOCUMENT\_CONVERTER\_OUTPUT\MIR ARCHIVE\UnconvertedMIRFiles

Note: 'Enable' the preview window functionality is only suitable for agent who has assigned a dedicated print device and Galileo Print Manager is installed on his/her computer.

If you select '**Disable**' – When a MIR file is unable to be converted by the script, the Unconverted MIR File Preview Window will not pop up and the original MIR file will be saved directly in the following folder.

C:\DOCUMENT\_CONVERTER\_OUTPUT\MIR ARCHIVE\UnconvertedMIRFiles


Note: 'Disable' the preview window functionality is suitable for a company which all ticket documents output are using one master print device. As a result, documents are saved in a common folder so that everyone in the company can access them.



For any reasons, you can select 'Cancel' to terminate the installation process.

### 2.3 Installation Wizard Completed

This is the confirmation screen after Document Converter has been installed.



Click on 'Finish' button to exit the wizard.

When you log on Galileo Desktop again, you will find a 'Document Converter' icon is added on the Custom Viewpoint Toolbar and a shortcut is created on your desktop.

#### 2) Shortcut on desktop




#### 2.4 Download iTextSharp File

After Document Converter setup is finished, you MUST go to the following site to download iTextSharp file version 4.1.2 (itextsharp-4.1.2-dll.zip). Please DO NOT DOWNLOAD other version because only version 4.1.2-dll.zip is compatible to Document Converter program.


Download and save the zip file in 'DOCUMENT\_CONVERTER\BIN' file first and extract it in the same file.



#### 2.5 Launch Document Converter


You may launch the Document Converter by:-

1) Clicking the icon on Custom ViewPoint Toolbar



or

2) Clicking Start ---> Program ---> Document Converter




or
