The Install Shield Developer 8 creates a setup file CVP 2.0.1 APAC Release.exe.

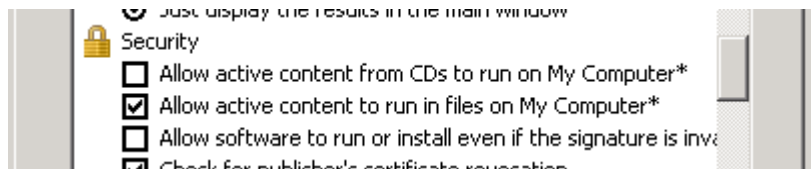
Click on this executable file.

The following software should be installed on the computer before installing this setup.

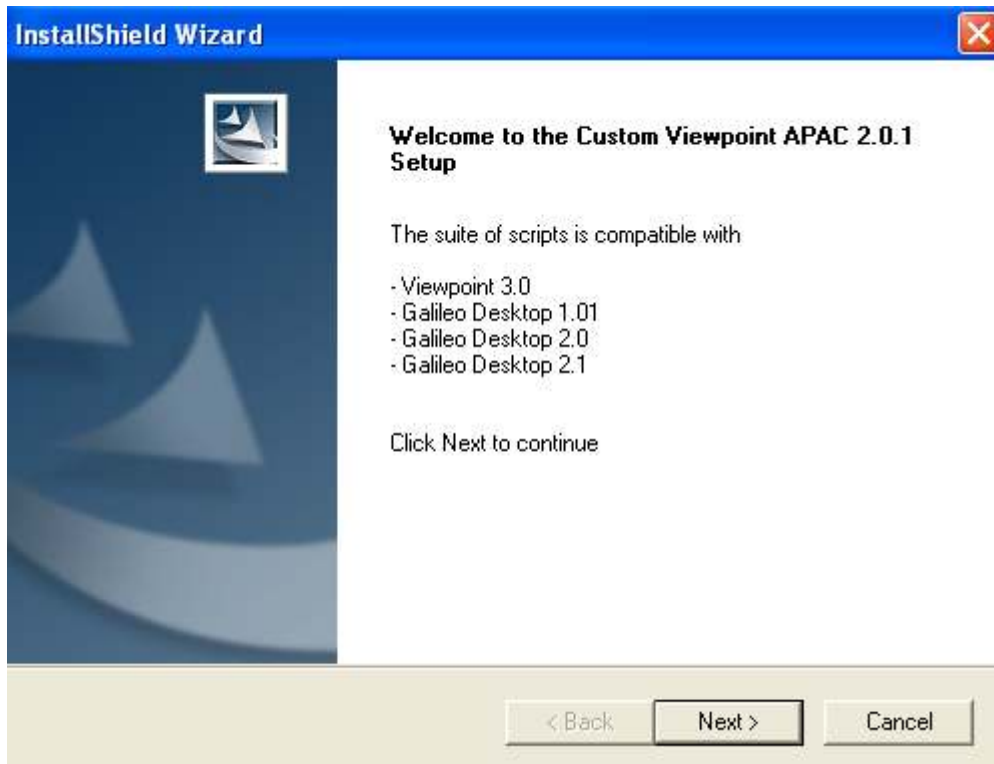
- Galileo Desktop 1.01 / 2.0 OR Viewpoint 3.0
- MS XML 6.0
- Browser settings
  - Tools Menu > Internet Options > Security Settings
- Select ADVANCED Tab
-

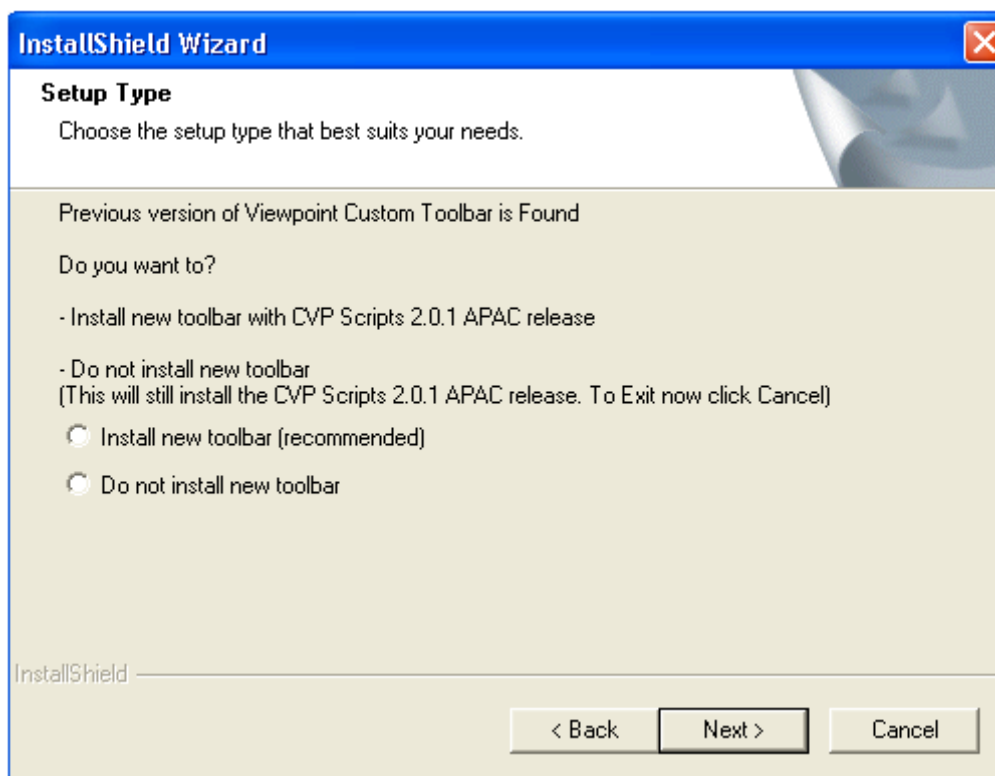

## Custom Viewpoint Scripts 2.0.1 EMEA Release

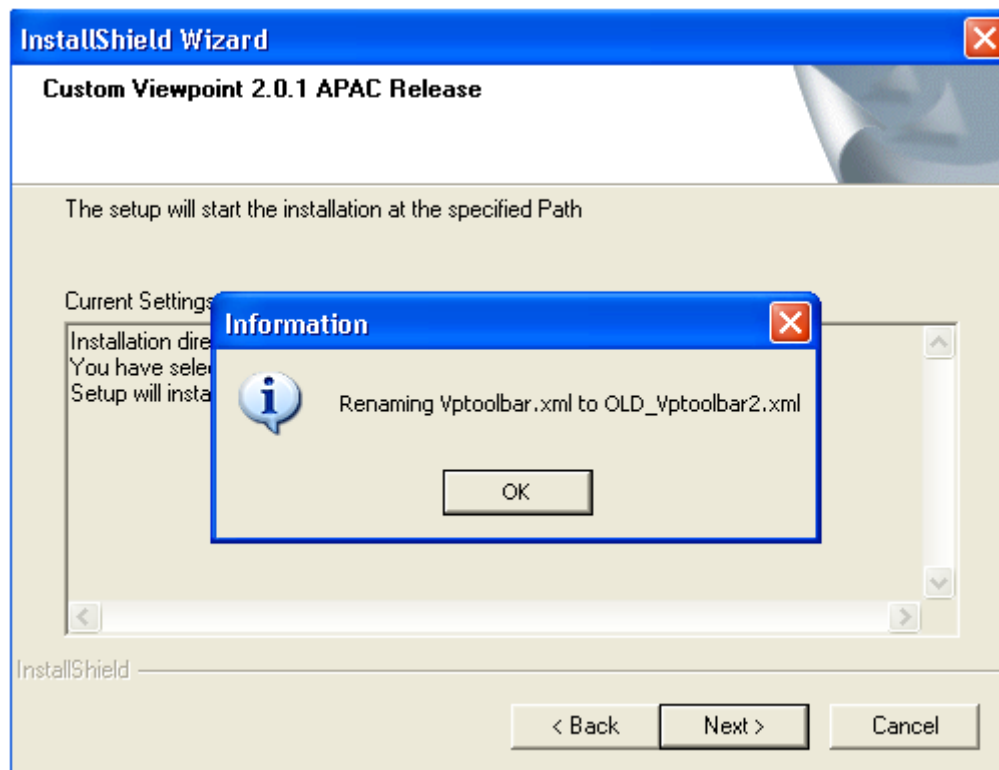
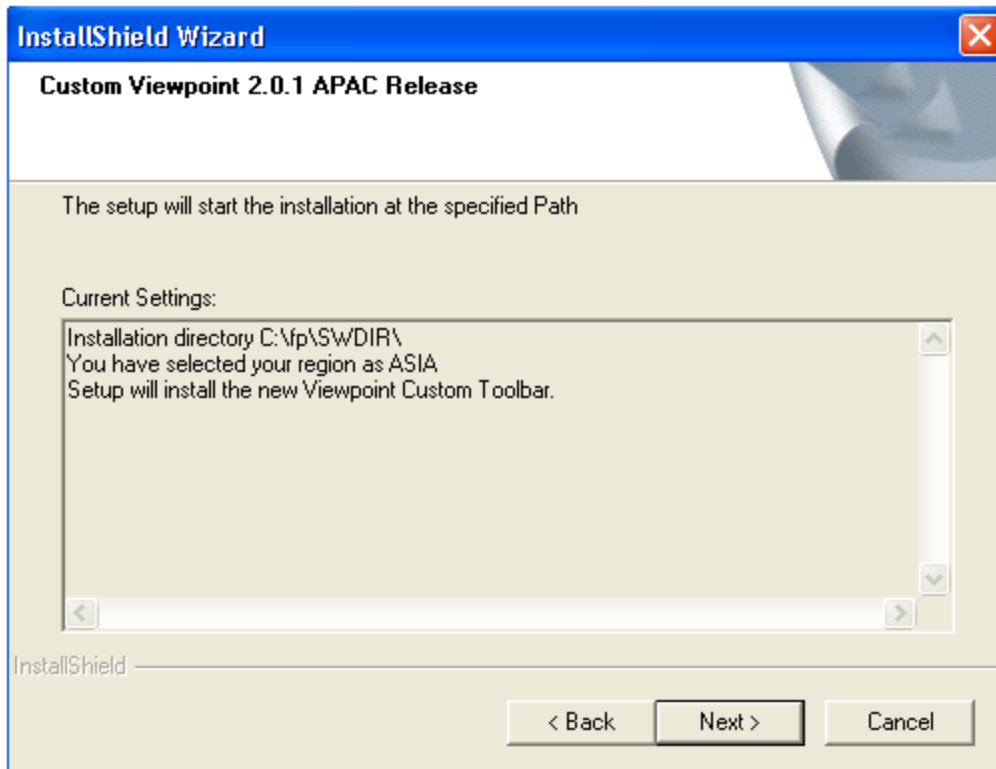
When the User Clicks the next button the Setup checks for the EMEA Installation at the backhand and if the EMEA is not installed, it will be installed by this setup.

This option would only be generated if Viewpoint Custom Toolbar is found



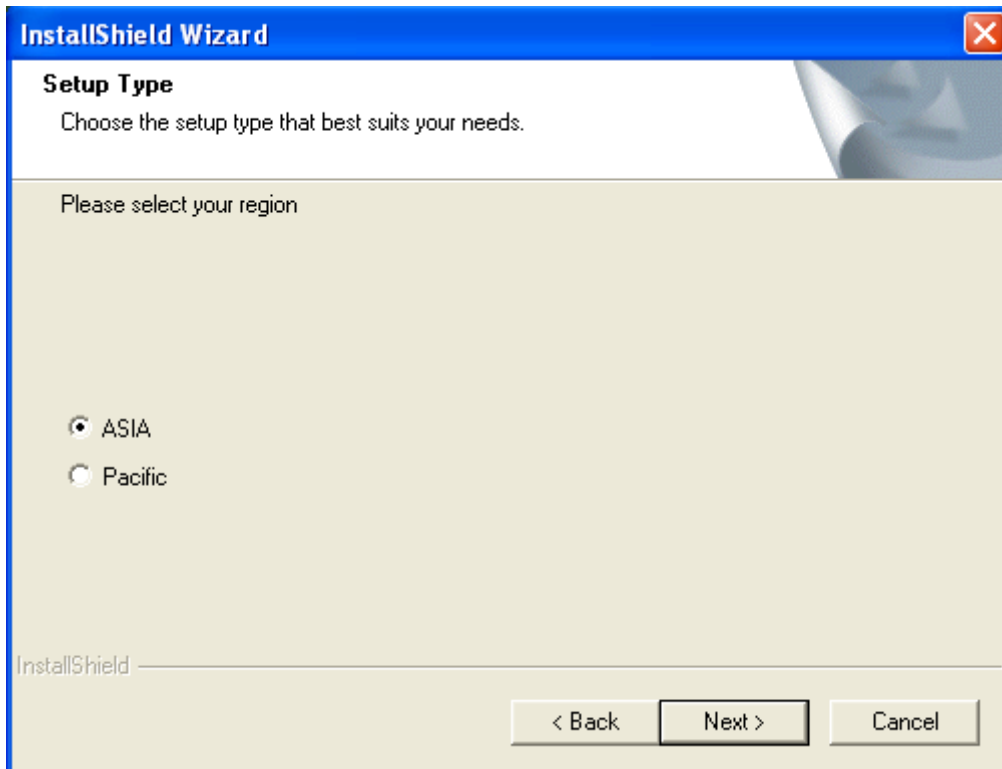

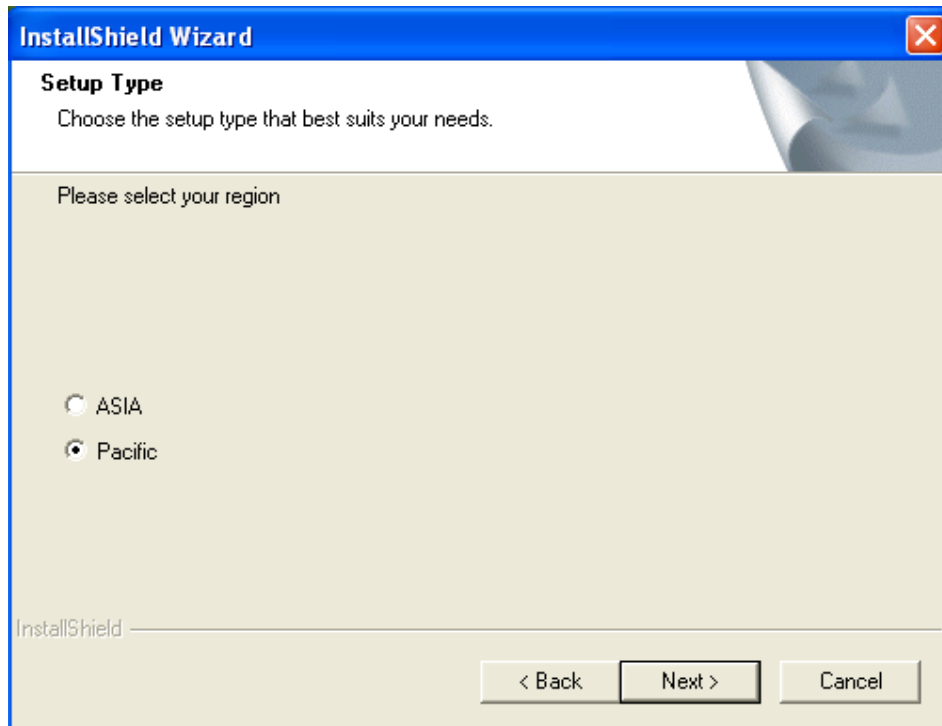

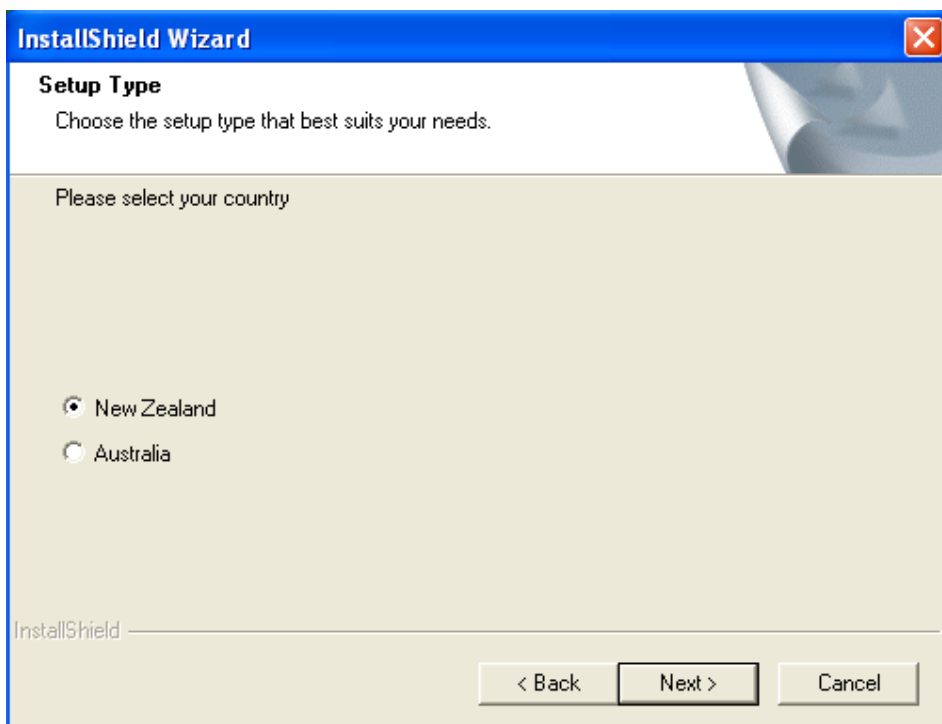


The dialog box will show which region has been selected to Install.

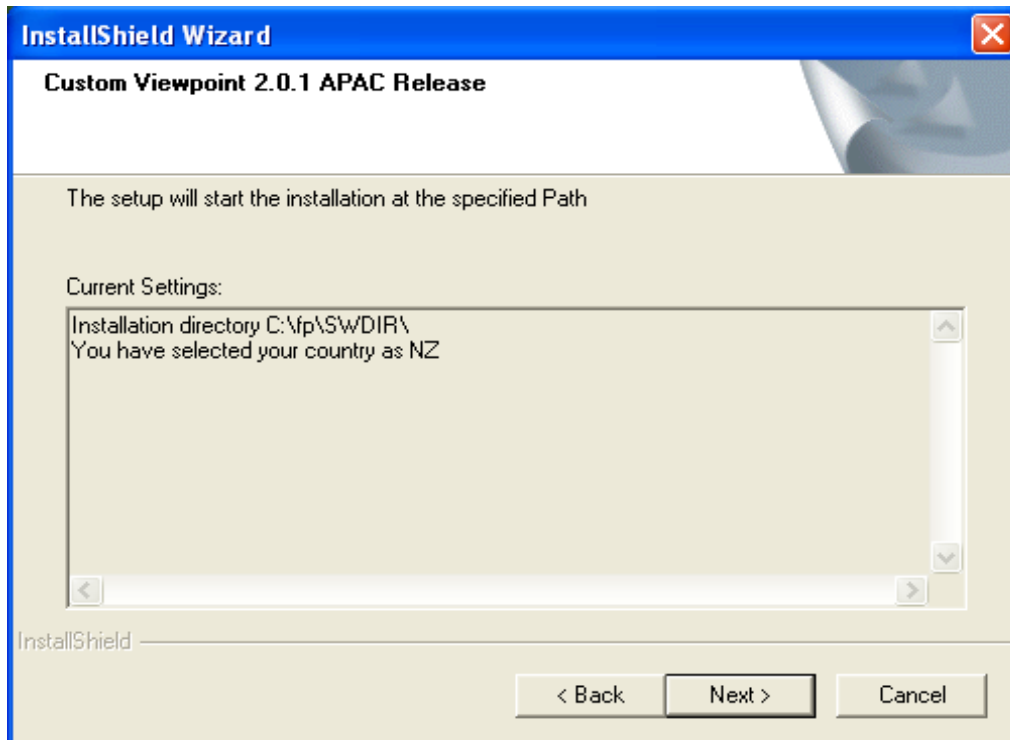

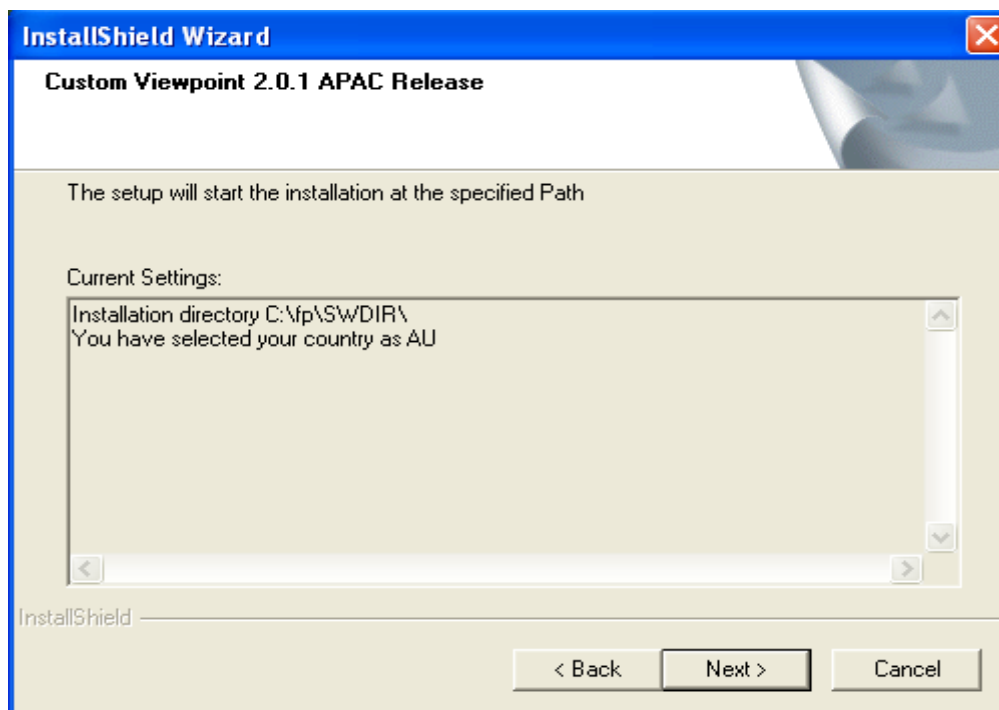
