Fare and Schedule Display (NAFQ)

HELP FSD

Fare and schedule display provides a list of available flights and the best fare offered for each flight. You can include a return date and other availability and pricing modifiers. Availability modifiers precede pricing modifiers. You can sell flights from this display.

Best Buy Quote prices the booked flights at the lowest available fare and provides up to six alternate itineraries with lower fares. Because Best Buy Quote checks availability of alternate itineraries, you can use it with pricing and availability modifiers. Pricing modifiers precede availability modifiers. A double slash (//) precedes availability modifiers.

Passenger Type Code (*)

HELP MOD*

Carriers file passenger type codes (PTCs) that apply to special passenger fares, such as senior, companion, youth, military, child, some private fares, etc. PTCs for the same special passenger can vary from fare to fare and carrier to carrier. The PTC required to price a special passenger fare appears below the fare line in the tariff display.

For fares that require age validation, such as senior, student, or child, add the passenger's age.

- If the PTC ends with NN (eg: SNN), enter the age *in place of* the NN. Example: \$B*\$65
- If the PTC does *not* end with NN (eg: SRC), enter the age *after* the PTC. Example: \$B*SRC65

PTC in Name Field Remarks

HELP NAME

When you include a PTC in the Name field remarks, it is not necessary to repeat the PTC in the pricing entry. If different PTCs are entered in the Name field remark and the pricing entry, the pricing entry PTC is read.

Accompanied Travel (ACC)

Use an accompaniment modifier to validate accompanied travel provisions on fares that require travel together, such as companions, children, and infants when accompanying passengers are on separate PNRs.

Fare Identification Code (H)

Use FIC with \$B or T:\$B but *not* \$BB, \$BBQ, or FS. If the itinerary does not qualify for the fare, the failed categories appear at the bottom of the display. Because FIC overrides the rules, it's your responsibility to ensure that all restrictions are met.

Storing Fares

When storing fares, you may use pricing and ticketing modifiers. When you combine modifiers, use a slash as a separator, *except* when combining name select or segment select with a fare identification code or with a passenger type code.
